ADFG/NOAA CARES

Section 12005 Fisheries Assistance Funding

The public comment period for the draft ADFG spend plan closed on October 23rd at 6:00 p.m. Significant pushback was received from the commercial fishing sector regarding the equal proposed allotment between the commercial harvesters, processing workers, and charter (sportfishing) operations.

The basic framework stipulates that eligible businesses must have incurred at least a 35% revenue loss compared to their past 5-year average. Businesses must apply to state of the owner's residence. You *can* receive Section 12005 fisheries assistance funding even if you have received other CARES Act funding.

An application process has not yet been finalized nor has the spend plan been finalized by NOAA. Funds will be distributed through the Pacific States Marine Fisheries Commission.
